The International Bowling Media Association (IBMA) may annually award scholarships to students attending college or graduating high school seniors planning on attending college. The scholarship is named in memory of IBMA, USBC, and PBA Hall of Fame journalist Chuck Pezzano. NCAUSBCA Second Vice President Noel Dysart died March 23 at age 79. A member of the association's Hall of Fame "Class of 2020," he is the second individual from last September's induction ceremonies (for years 2020 and 2021) to die, following the January 28 passing of Lorenzo "Zone" Holland (2021). Dysart, who began volunteering at the association office in 1997, retired from the Navy in 2002 and soon began serving as a director until the 2006 merger of the local men's, women's, and youth associations. He managed Bethesda Naval Bowling Center from 2008 to its closure in 2019. He chaired the Rerate Committee from 2012 to 2019 and headed the Lane Inspection Team from 2013 to 2018. He returned to the NCAUSBCA board in 2021 and was elected Second Vice President at the 2022 Annual Membership Meeting.

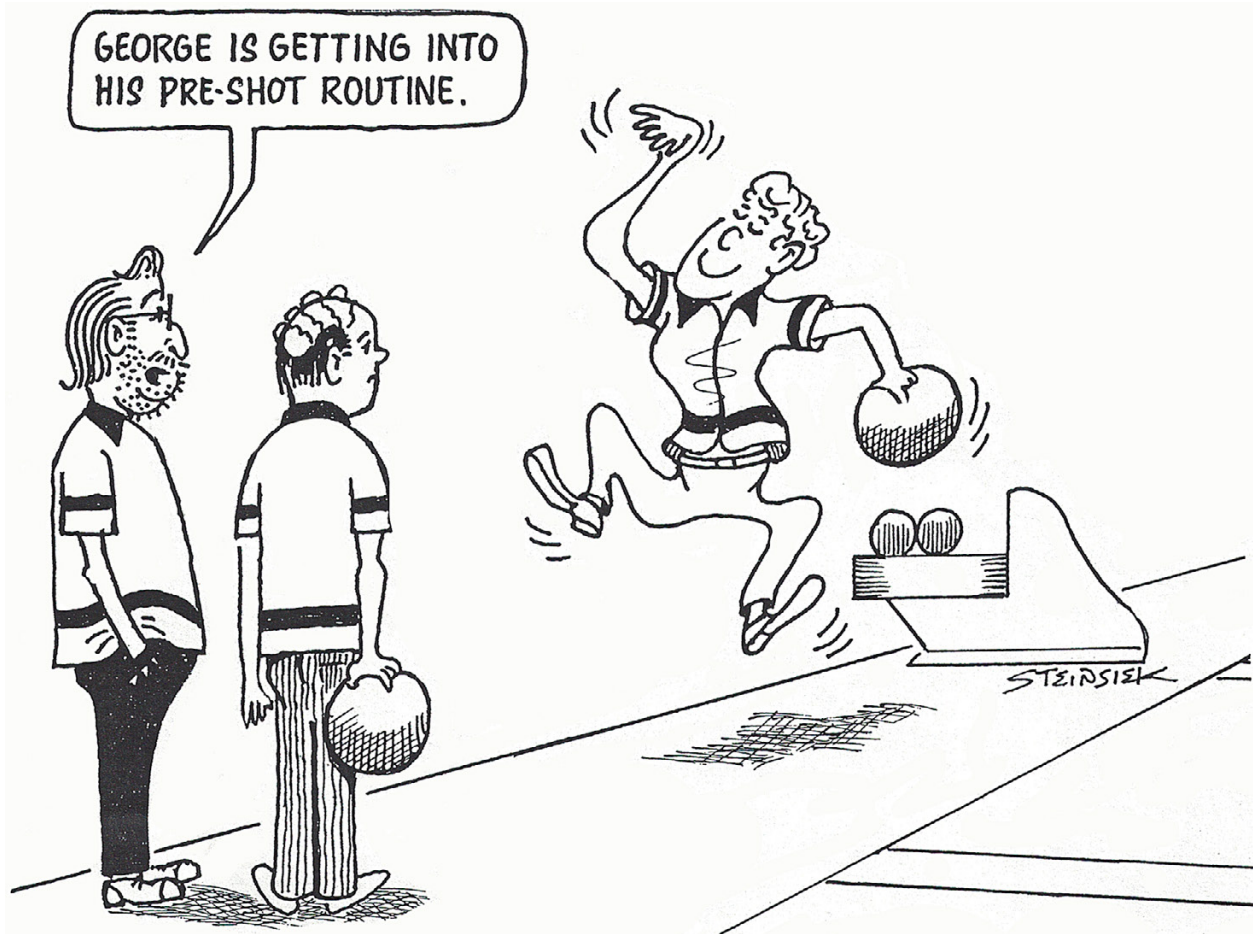

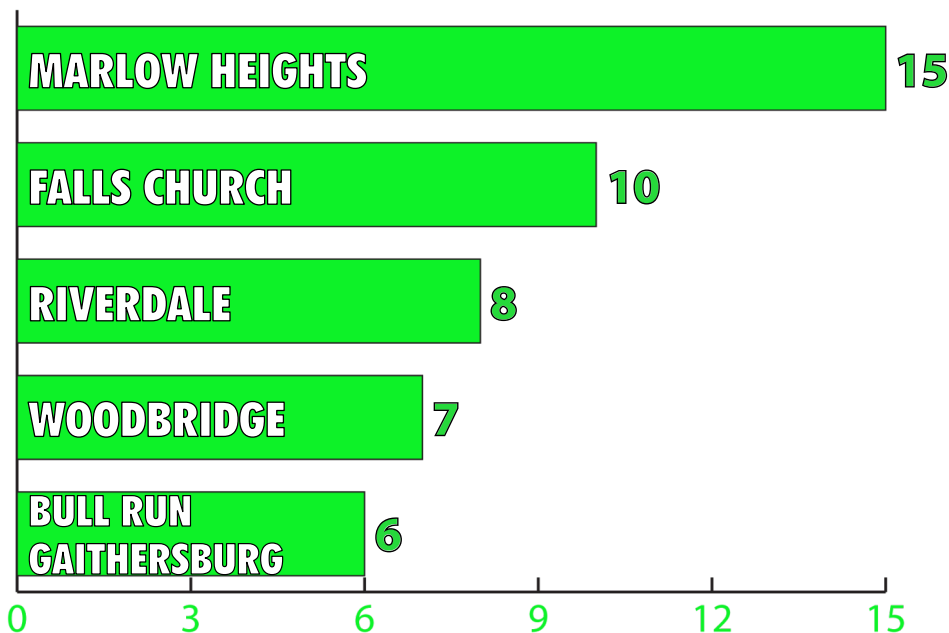

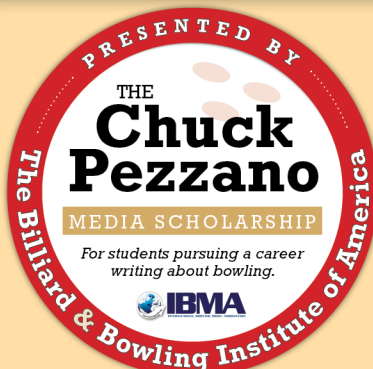
