Crofton's Michael Cordes wins division title at USBC Senior Championships

CINCINNATI – A dozen competitors, including one NCAUSBCA member, earned titles at the 2024 United States Bowling Congress Senior Championships, which concluded August 1 at Western Bowl Strike and Spare.

The top six bowlers across two divisions — Open and Women's – in six age-based classifications — 50-54, 55-59, 60-64, 65-69, 70-74, 75 and older, rolled their final round of three games to decide who walked away with championship trophies.

The national event featured men's and women's bowlers age 50 and older who qualified through either a state or province (Canada) senior tournament.

Qualifying scores from the first six games of competition were not carried over to the championship rounds, but bonus pins were awarded to each player based on his or her qualifying position. The top qualifier in each classification received 50 bonus pins, while the second seed received 40. Bonus pins decreased by 10 pins for each spot, with the sixth qualifier receiving zero bonus pins. The bowlers authoring the highest three-game totals on the final day, including handicap and bonus pins, earned titles.

BOCKSTIE EARNS TWO SILVER MEDALS AT IBF WORLD CHAMPIONSHIPS

Junior Team USA member Jake Bockstie of Nottingham, Md., last month took home two silver medals at the 2024 International Bowling Federation World Youth Championships in Incheon, Korea. His team, which included Zach Andresen of Princeton, Minn., Brandon Bohn of Jackson, N.J., and Braden Mallasch of Waupaca, Wis., placed second, falling to the Czech Republic by a final score of 2-1 (224-234, 224-184, and 180-204) during the gold-medal match at Incheon's Fiesta Bowling Center. Bockstie teamed with Bohn to earn his second silver medal, as the duo was swept 2-0 in the finals by the German team of Max Lorenz and Paul Purps, 226-166 and 244-207.

McLANE, TRENTLER EARN JUNIOR TEAM USA SPOTS

Six boys and six girls from the U18 division recently earned spots on Junior Team USA for 2025 based on their performance at the Junior Gold Championships in Detroit. Among those joining the team are two NCAUSBCA members from Maryland, Chance McLane of Chesapeake Beach and Nicolas Trentler of Phoenix. ... Kayla Starr of Crofton, Md., placed third in the Girls U18 division.

EPPS ROLLS FIRST CAREER 300 AT USBC OPEN CHAMPIONSHIPS

Deborah Epps of Temple Hills, Md., had been close to perfection a time or two in her bowling career but still was in search of her first 300 as she made her way to Las Vegas for the 2024 USBC Open Championships. She returns home with a story to tell and an accomplishment checked off her list as she was able to connect for her first perfect game July 20 during her singles event at the South Point Bowling Plaza to cap off a successful debut at the tournament. Epps, a former collegiate bowler at Fairleigh Dickinson University, started singles with 204 before rolling 300 in Game 2, and she finished with 172 for a 676 series. She added 647 in doubles and 616 in team for an all-events total of 1,939.

It is hard to believe that two years have passed by so quickly. The work was hard, but the memories were precious. 2023-2024 Season Recap

As you read this, the Fall/Winter 2023-2024 season is over, and you are eagerly looking forward to another bowling season.

We had a membership gain of about one percent last season, which is great, considering that we had been losing about five percent of membership per year for as long as I can remember. Just think, NCAUSBCA had 21,241 members at the end of the 2013-2014 season. At this year's USBC Convention, it was reported that there was a three percent increase nationally. Let us hope the trend keeps going.

Our local tournaments have also seen an increase in participation. Crofton Bowling Centre hosted this year's singles/doubles event. All had a good time, and we greatly appreciate all of the help and the fine service provided by staff. More entries means more prize money.

Scratch bowlers, where are you? I noticed the Open Tournament participation in the scratch events was equal to or down from the previous year. Overall entering averages were higher than last year. Go figure!

Reminder: Memberships purchased during the summer expired July 31 or when the league ends. If you plan to bowl the 2024-2025 season, you will need to purchase a new membership, the cost of which will be \$28.00. Yes, the cost of a local membership is now \$12.00. By the way, this is the

first local dues increase in 13 years. Please make sure your secretary submits your summer league average as soon as the league ends. Some tournaments are now using the season's average, and that includes summer.

Please make it a point to attend your league organization meeting; this will most likely be the only chance you will have to fix problems with your rules. Once the first ball is rolled, it will be almost impossible to correct problems. *Those who show up at that first meeting get to make the rules for everybody else.*

The NCAUSBCA awards program has been revamped based on suggestions from those who attended our Annual Membership Meeting held in February. There is something in this program for all bowlers at all skill levels. Secretaries, please update your BLS software program with the new requirements.

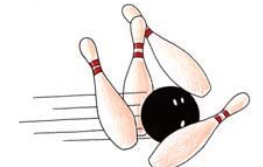

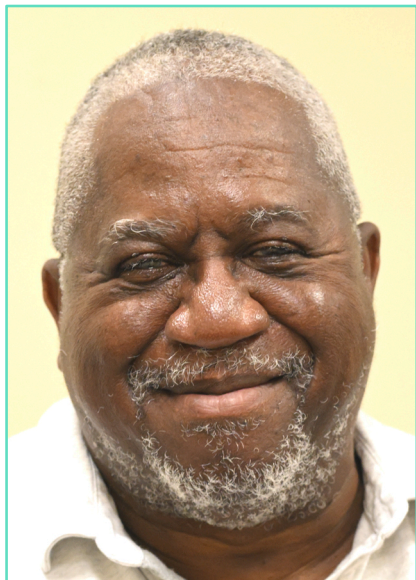

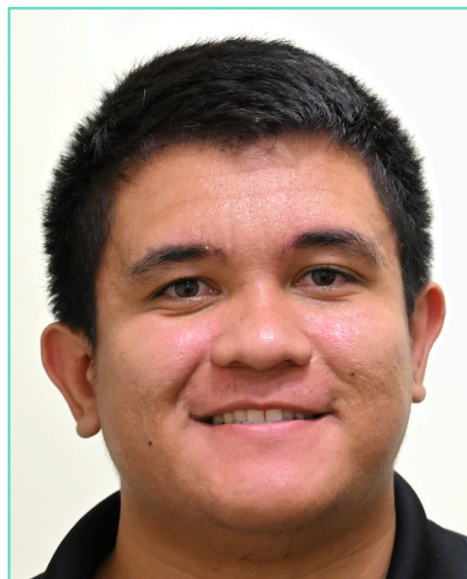

The Best Bowling Tip I Ever Received

By Ta'Shawn Jones



Around 2007 or 2008, I bowled in the Dale City Junior/Majors youth league. My coach, "Coach Mac," noticed that I would get frustrated and this would mess up my game.

"You only have two seconds to be upset about a frame, two minutes to be upset about a game, and two hours to be upset about your set," he told me.

His words helped me tremendously with my mental game and my ability to focus. Without getting frustrated all the time, it helps with keeping a clear mind. Keeping a clear mind creates better understanding of what is happening on the lane and what adjustments that need to be made.

Today, I am running this same program in hopes of growing the next generation of youth bowlers and making sure that they understand the fundamentals and passing on the same message Coach Mac told me when I was bowling there.

Ta'Shawn teamed with Hall of Famer Roger Rowley to win the Scratch Doubles event in the recent NCAUSBCA 78th Annual Open Championships Tournament. Earlier this summer, Ta'Shawn was the highest finishing local casher, placing ninth in the PBA Bowlero Manassas Open at Bowl America Bull Run.

In the Open 65-69 division, No. 1 seed Michael Cordes of Crofton, Md., won by the narrowest of margins as he bested second-place finisher Ron Braaten of Ludlow, South Dakota, by just one pin, 685 to 684.

According to Cordes, who earned \$700 for his victory and was bowling in the event for the first time, Braaten was "50 to 60 pins" behind coming down the stretch, but got on a string of strikes.

"The scoring machines don't add up your string of strikes as you go," said Cordes. "Given that, plus with the handicap and bonus pins, I don't think there was any way he (Braaten) knew what he needed in the 10th . . . none of us did. Turns out he needed eight pins on his

last shot to tie and nine to win, but he got a seven-count. Very fortunate for me."

Braaten entered Friday as the No. 6 seed, so he didn't have the benefit of any bonus pins. His 549 scratch total was 49 pins better than Cordes' 500, and each bowler got 135 pins of handicap. In the end, it was Cordes' 50 bonus pins for being the No. 1 seed that made the one-pin difference.

Meanwhile, John Smothers of Bowie, Md., took home \$300 for his fifth-place finish in the Open 60-64 division.

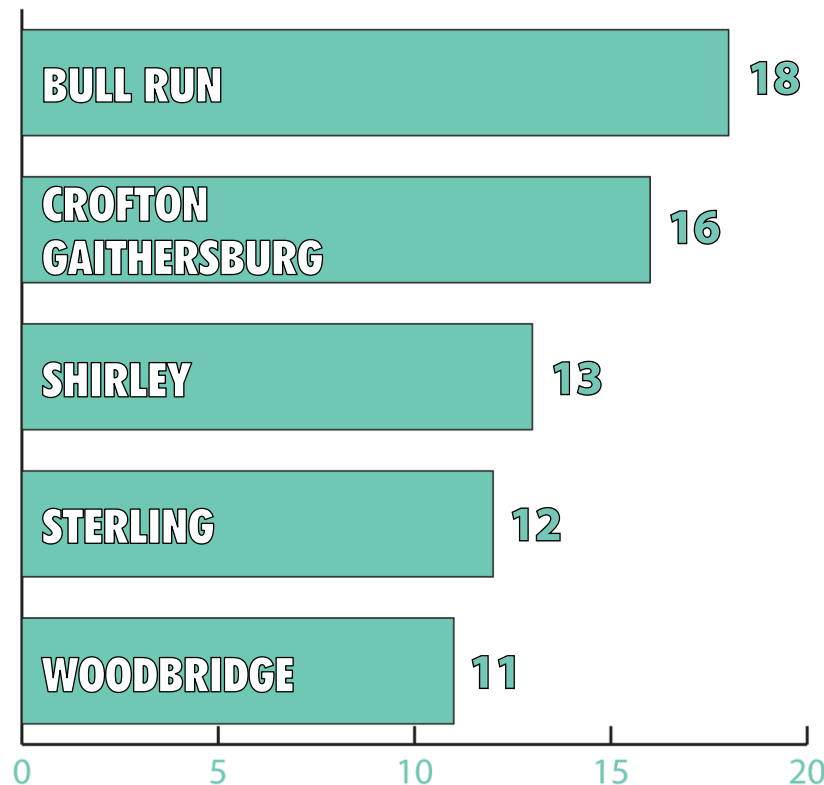
