We "R" One Tournament Rules & Regulations

- Qualifications: All members of USBC in good standings are eligible to participate. Non-USBC members can qualify by paying an associate membership fee of \$20.00. All participants will be required to show their certification cards at check-in time.
- Entries: This tournament will be set up as a handicap and scratch three person doubles tournament, with any combination of bowlers. The team entry lineup must contain all required information, entry fees and order of the players. Upon receipt of entries, no changes to the lineup will be permitted.

 Bowlers will use their highest certified average based on a minimum of 21 games for the 2006-2007 season. If no average last season, use highest current certified average based on a minimum of 21 games as of the date of participation in this tournament. All others will bowl scratch. "Association average books or secretarial verification will be accepted. The 10-pin rule waived. It is the bowler's responsibility to verify the accuracy of their average no matter who may submit the average. Failure to use the correct average or make corrections prior to completion of the 1st game shall disqualify score if average used is incorrect. Bowler can bowl on as many teams as they desire; however, not more than 2 bowlers from the same team can place more than once on the handicap prize list. The Tournament Director reserves the right to reject any entry and any entry fee.
- 3) **Handicap:** A handicap of 80% of the difference between 210 and the entering average of bowlers. All others will bowl scratch.
- 4) **Substitutes:** Substitutes are permitted and must be in good standings with USBC. No changes can be made in the order of the lineup. The substitute will be placed in the position of the bowler he/she is replacing.
- 5) Entry Fee: Mail-in entry fee is \$25.00 Per Person, \$75.00 Per Team, which includes a FREE entry into an Individual Female/Male High Game Scratch for the weekend. Fees are based on team of three players payoff. Fees distribution is \$36.00 prize fund, \$30.00 bowling fee and \$9.00 administrative fee. Walk-ins are welcome and must pay \$30.00 cash Per Person. After an entry has been received and processed by the Tournament Director, no fees shall be refunded. INSUFFICIENT FUND CHECKS FEE WILL BE \$30.00 PLUS ENTRY FEES.
- Prize Money: The prize fund ratio will be paid out on a scale of 1-3, based on participation of 30 teams. Prize money returned at 100%. Payoff for the tournament will take place after the scores have been verified with the tournament officials.
- Bowling Rule: This is a Three Person Doubles' Bowling Tournament using the two highest scores per game for total score. All three bowlers will bowl 4 games across 8 lanes. In the event of a first place tie, a 9th and 10th frame roll off will be bowled to determine the winner. Ties for other than first place shall be divided equally for that position's prize money. Tournament officials will verify all scores.
- **Disputes:** Any disputes of scores or any other problems must be made know to the Tournament Director prior to payoff.
- 9) Check-In Time: All bowlers must check-in at least 30 minutes prior to starting time. Walk-ins entries close 15 minutes prior to the starting or when lane availability has been maximized.
- **Late Bowlers:** All bowlers will receive a zero for all frames missed. Late bowlers will be permitted to bowl in the frame that is being bowled. No absentee or vacancy scores shall be permitted (only scores bowled).
- 11) **Decisions:** All decisions of the Tournament Director are final.
